## 20<sup>th</sup> WORLD AIDS DAY

World AIDS Day, observed December 1 (the anniversary of the first AIDS diagnosis), is dedicated to raising awareness of the global AIDS epidemic caused by the spread of HIV infection.

The concept originated at the 1988 World Summit of Ministers of Health on Programmes for AIDS Prevention. Since then, it has been taken up by governments, international organizations and charities around the world.

World AIDS Day is not just about raising money, but also about increasing awareness, education and fighting prejudice. World AIDS Day is important in reminding people that HIV has not gone away, and that there is much work to be done, whether in Africa or here in our beloved Kingston.
